ONLINE ADOLESCENT HEALTH AND DEVELOPMENT (AHD) PROGRAM IN CALABARZON (PILOT ACTIVITY)

To All Schools Division Superintendents

- The Commission on Population and Development CALABARZON through the Technical Working Group on Adolescent Pregnancy of which the Department of Education IV A CALABARZON is a member, will conduct a Pilot Online Activity on Adolescent Health and Development Program in selected secondary schools in CALABARZON for Calendar Year 2021.
- The objective is to impart the right information related to adolescent sexuality through particular demand generation activities such as Teenage Pregnancy Symposium (April-May 2021) and AHD Film Dissemination (October-November 2021).
- 3. Target are grades 8-10 learners including their respective advisers with a maximum of 100 participants per session and a maximum of 2 hours duration per session. We encourage the Schools Division Offices to reach the minimum goal of 100 participants in their respective Division.
- 4. The Schools Division Office' Adolescent Health Focal Person in coordination with the respective City/Municipal Population Officer will determine the specific schools and schedule as guided by the attached Program Design and Implementation Plan. The List of Provincial/City/Municipal Population Officers and sample Program are attached for your reference.
- 5. Electronic certificate of attendance will be awarded by the PopCom 4A upon completion of the program to both learners and advisers.


