REITERATION OF POLICIES ON ADMISSION IN BASIC EDUCATION

To Schools Division Superintendents
Public and Private School Heads
All others concerned

- This office reiterates the relevant department orders on admission policies which shall guide all public and private schools including SUCs/LUCs in each beginning of school year.
- With reference to DepEd Order No. 3, s. 2018, all concerned schools offering basic education programs shall adhere to existing rules that govern the minimum eligibility and documentary requirements for enrollment in order to establish the identity of learners.
- Likewise, in line with DepEd Order No. 20, s. 2018, it is hereby reminded that all
 incoming Kindergarten and Grade 1 learners shall strictly comply with the policy
 on age cut-off and eligibility standards.
- 4. The summary of these standards and requirements including the guidelines on enrollment in special cases can be found in the attached **Annex A** and **Annex B**.
- 5. The School Governance Operations Division of each schools division office are enjoined to monitor the strict adherence on these admission policies.
- 6. Failure to comply with these admission policies may be a ground for administrative disciplinary remedies against personnel of public schools and private schools.

7. Immediate dissemination and compliance to this memorandum is directed.
