2021 WASH IN SCHOOLS MASSIVE OPEN ONLINE COURSE (WINS MOOC)

To: Schools Division Superintendents of Antipolo City, Bacoor City, Cavite City, Cavite Province, Dasmarinas City, General Trias City, Imus City, Lucena City, Quezon Province, Rizal Province, Tayabas City

- In reference to OUA Memo 00-0721-0010, the Bureau of Education Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) through the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division in cooperation with GIZ personnel and managed by the CALABARZON WINS MOOC Regional Management Team is offering two (2) self-paced WinS MOOC courses namely Accelerating WinS and Leading WinS.
- 2. This September to November 2021 Batch is offered to participants from the 11 selected Schools Divisions. Each SDO is to choose 18 elementary schools and 18 high schools. If the SDO cannot fill the 36 schools allotted, kindly alert immediately Dr. Intia, so that the slots can be given to the other SDOs. Details are in Enclosure A.
- 3. Participants are to register online for your personal information via https://bit.ly/WINSMOOCSEPT2021 before August 31, 2021. This will be the basis for creating a group chat for easier guidance and monitoring. All participants are to join the respective group chat as indicated in Enclosure B.
- 4. By August 31, GIZ will issue the a) How to Enroll Guide, b) Course Links, and c) enrolment keys that are unique for each region.
- 5. Participants are required to have an account at the official DepEd LMS: https://training.deped.gov.ph/. This is a requirement and essential in managing the courses.
