CONCEPT NOTE

Review and Finalization of Transition Program Policy

In 2019, the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Learning Delivery - Student Inclusion Division (BLD-SID) conducted workshops for the development, validation, and finalization of policy guidelines for the transition program for learners with severe to profound disabilities. This proposed policy provides suggested learning delivery modalities that learners with severe to profound disabilities may choose from or deemed appropriate for them.

The COVID-19 challenges compelled DepEd to offer different learning delivery modalities to all types of learners, including learners with disabilities. The rapid online survey on the Situation of Children with Disabilities in the Context of COVID19 of the Save the Children in 2020, under the right to participation, recommends mapping out different sectors (children, youth, parents, civil society organizations, private sector) that advocate for disability-inclusion and identify the support they provide to establish a network that will nurture engagement and participation both online and offline.

On August 20, 2020, DepEd Order No. 21, s. 2020 Policy Guidelines on the Adoption of the K to 12 Transition Curriculum Framework for Learners with Disabilities was issued. The policy provides transition curriculum packages and desired exit outcomes. Thus, there is a need to anchor the proposed BLD-SID policy on transition programs for learners with disabilities to ensure alignment and harmonization.

With the issuance of the DO 21, s. 2020 and the introduction of different learning delivery modalities to learners with disabilities, there is a need to review the proposed policy of the BLD-SID on the transition program for learners with disability.

Cognizant of the above, the BLD-SID shall conduct an online consultation with the proponents of the DO 21, s. 2020 and select schools implementing transition programs in the country on April 6-7, 2022. This will be followed by a workshop on the Review and Finalization of Transition Program Policy on April 25-29, 2022.

Workshop on the Review and Finalization of Transition Program Policy April 25-29, 2022

The invited participants to the workshop on the review and finalization of the proposed transition program policy are select region and division supervisors who have knowledge in managing transition programs and teachers who implemented transition programs.

The BLD-SID will present the outputs of the two-day consultation workshop conducted on April 6-7, 2022. The resource person/consultant will provide ideas on how the transition programs can be workable and effective for the Filipino learners with disabilities.

The BLD-SID staff shall facilitate the five-day review and writing of the transition program policy. The participants will be divided into three groups. Each group will be provided with copies of the following:

draft transition program policy;

· recommendations of participants of consultation workshop; and

• DepEd Order No. 21, s. 2020 Policy Guidelines on the Adoption of the K to 12 Transition Curriculum Framework for Learners with Disabilities.



A template will be provided to each group to discuss what to include, change or delete in the draft transition policy. The output of each group will be flashed on screen on the $5^{\rm th}$ day. The consultant will appreciate and challenge each group if after hearing the presentations of other groups, they would like to re-think the output of the group. The outputs will be returned to each group for them to finalize and submit to the BLD-SID program management team.

The final copy of the proposed transition program policy for learners with disabilities will be written by the BLD-SID staff in consultation with the resource person/consultant.
