- FOR THE SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICE

- a. The SDO will create google classroom/s depending on the number of schools to be validated.
- Send Google Classroom invitation to the Regional Validators assigned to your Division.
- c. For each classroom, five (5) Google Folders must be created. Four (4) folders must be created which are intended for the 4 principles and one (1) folder for the Preliminary documents. Generate Meeting link for the validation proper.
- d. Ensure the completeness of documents uploaded by Schools.
- e. Include RO Validators and SDO Personnel as teachers.
