Please be guided that only confirmed participants with QR codes can enter the venue and that the QR code is non-transferable. Meals and accommodation only for the confirmed onsite participants shall be provided on June 19-20, 2022. Dinner is the first meal on June 19 and the last meal is breakfast on June 21 for the onsite participants.

Travelling and other incidental expenses of the onsite participants shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

The Schools Division Offices (SDOs) in Region VI and the host region shall be allowed to utilize their local funds to augment additional expenses incidental to the conduct of the event which are not covered by the downloaded funds from EPS.
