
**DEPED CALABARZON DELEGATES TO THE 2021 NATIONAL





Pursuant to the DepEd Memorandum (DM) No. 48, s. 2021 entitled "*Brigada Eskwela (BE) Implementing Guidelines*," the External Partnerships Service (EPS), shall be conducting the **2021 Brigada Eskwela National Awards on June 20, 2022 at the Iloilo Convention Center (ICON), Iloilo City.**

The 2021 National BE Awards aims to honor the efforts of the teachers, learners and parents during the implementation of last year's BE Implementation in support to the preparations for the opening of classes based on the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP) of the Department.

On June 20, 2022, a total of 128 awardees from the best implementing schools at the elementary and secondary levels shall be recognized during the ceremony. Special awards such as Best School-Community-Home Partnerships, Best Home Learning Spaces, and Best Partnership Engagement Activity, among others, shall also be recognized during the event.

In compliance to the strict implementation of the minimum health protocols for the conduct of the face-to-face activity, **only the following DepEd personnel are identified to join the onsite awarding ceremony:**

7. Schools Division Superintendents of the Best Implementing School awardees

A Google Form to be filled out by the Regional Partnership Focal Persons to confirm BE Awards participants for registration, accommodation and certificate preparation shall be provided through email.

Meanwhile, **school representatives for the Special Awards category shall participate virtually via Zoom platform.** The link shall be provided to the pre-registered participants with specific instruction few days before the event. Please see Enclosure 1 for the Pre-Registration Process. Confirmed pre-registered onsite participants shall be provided with a QR code to enter the event venue. Please be guided that only confirmed participants with QR codes can enter the venue and that the QR code is non-transferable. **The awardee's recommended attire is a choice of Regional Costume or Filipiniana for female and Barong for male.**

**Meals and accommodation only for the confirmed onsite participants shall be provided on June 19-20, 2022.** Dinner is the first meal on June 19 and the last meal is breakfast on June 21 for the onsite participants.

Travelling and other incidental expenses of the onsite participants shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

The Schools Division Offices (SDOs) in Region VI and the host region shall be allowed to utilize their local funds to augment additional expenses incidental to the conduct of the event which are not covered by the downloaded funds from EPS.
