**REGIONAL VIRTUAL WORKSHOP ON READING
INTERVENTION AND REGIONAL VIRTUAL WORKSHOP ON
ASSESSMENT-DRIVEN INTERVENTION
FOR ENGLISH AND FILIPINO**

To **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. This is in reference to the letter from the Regional Association of Communication Arts Supervisors (RACAS), informing the field about the above-mentioned activity on July 13-15, 2022, and August 3-5, 2022, respectively.
2. The virtual-seminar workshop particularly aims to develop and implement recovery plans and scholastic activities for all learners in all key stages to recover and reinforce reading and assessment-driven intervention specific to the gradual transition from Distance Learning Modality to Limited Face-to-Face Modality.
3. Participants in these activities are the following:
 - a. For the Regional Workshop on Reading Intervention, all reading teachers from key stages 1 to 3 are encouraged to attend especially those who attended the Phase 1 and 2 Reading Training conducted at Tanza Oasis. However, those who have finished the three phases may not attend the said training.
 - b. For the Regional Workshop on Assessment-Driven Intervention, all teachers from key stages 1 to 4 and teaching any of the learning areas are encouraged to attend the training.
4. A registration fee of Two Hundred Pesos (Php 200.00) per virtual workshop will be collected from each participant to defray expenses for the honorarium of six (6) speakers and subscription to Stream Yard professional plan and other related-activity expenses. This can be charged to school MOOE subject to usual auditing and accounting procedures.



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5. Further, a meeting to be attended by RACAS Officers and all EPSs of English and Filipino shall be held on **July 4, 2022**, at **1:00 PM** via online platform. Link will be sent to the RACAS group chat a day before the meeting. In addition, Performance Implementation Review (PIR) shall be held on **August 9, 2022**, in a venue to be announced later. All EPSs of English and Filipino are required to attend and present their re-entry plans and other related output of the Webinars.
