Guidelines for Online Presentation of Research Studies

General Reminders

- a. The session moderator will introduce the researchers at the beginning of the forum.
- b. The 20-minute video presentation will be played and focuses on the research results, conclusion and recommendations.
- c. Follow the prescribed outline and content of presentation below:

Outline	Content
Title of the Study (1 slide)	Title of the study, researchers, workstation, Division Office
Introduction/Rationale/Background of the Study (1 slide)	Describe the problem or issue that inspires the researcher/s to conduct the study.
Statement of the Problem (1-2 slides)	Present the statement of the problem.
Theoretical/Conceptual Framework (1 slide)	Present also the theoretical or conceptual framework being used in the study
Methodology and Scope of the Study (1-2 slides)	Present the research design, methodology, respondents, research locale and ethical consideration
Research Findings (1-7 slides)	Present the findings in each specific research question or objective. Use graphic organizers or pictures to support your findings.
Conclusion and Recommendations (1-3 slides)	Short conclusion synthesizing the findings. Specify recommendations based on the findings.
References (1 slide)	In bullet form, present relevant references used in the study.
