In response to item 81 of DepEd Order No. 21, s. 2019 entitled "Policy Guidelines on the K to 12 Basic Education Program which states that *there will be a separate issuance of policy guidelines for multigrade in secondary schools*, the Bureau of Learning Delivery through the Teaching and Learning Division (BLD-TLD) will conduct a workshop on the formulation of policy guidelines on the pilot implementation of the Multigrade (MG) Program in Junior High School (JHS) to be held at Eurotel, North EDSA, Quezon City on July 3 – 9, 2022. This activity aims to refine the draft policy guidelines for the pilot expansion of the MG Program in JHS.

The participants (please see attached list) are regional and division MG coordinators, public schools district supervisors, and school heads of the target pilot schools for the MG-JHS in the participating regions. The activity shall commence at 8:00 AM on Monday, July 4, 2022. The participants are expected to share their experiences and practices on the MG Program that will contribute to improving the context of the policy guidelines.
