preparation for the implementation of the Contextualized MELCs-based ALS SHS Curriculum in their respective regions, schools divisions, schools and/or community learning centers.

The listed teacher-participants are required to bring their own laptops and copy of the MELCs of their assigned core or applied subject during the training. **The National Core of Trainers listed in Attachment No. 1 (Letter L) shall attend in both clusters and arrive one day before the activity in the venue (September 11 and September 18, respectively) .**

The participants are also requested to comply with all COVID-19 Alert Level System protocols set by the national and local Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging and Infectious Diseases (IATF), as well as the most recent DepEd rules and/or policies.
