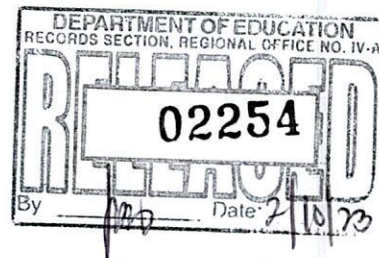

1. Relative to the Regional Memorandum No. 50, s. 2023 re: Virtual Research O'clock, this Office announces the use of a link for the submission of completed research papers (in PDF format) and video presentations of the select Seventh Cycle Basic Education Research Fund (BERF) grantees.
2. To access the link, use **bit.ly/VROsubmission**. Only the Senior Education Program Specialists (SEPSs) for Planning and Research or the Schools Division Office (SDO) Research Coordinators are allowed to access the link.
3. The participants are likewise advised to register through **tinyurl.com/VROregistration** on or before February 13, 2023. The select Seventh Cycle BERF grantees, Regional Research Committee (RRC), SEPSs for Planning and Research or SDO Research Coordinators, and PPRD Secretariat will be given priority since there is a maximum number of registrants to be allowed.
4. Please take note of the following reminders to ensure smooth flow of the activity:
 - The select Seventh Cycle BERF grantees must ensure that their research paper and video presentation were submitted by their SEPS or SDO Research Coordinator in the abovementioned link to avoid any inconvenience during the activity;
 - The Secretariat will send the link of the video conference via email before the conduct of the activity;
 - The video presentation that exceeds the five-minute maximum number of allowed presentation will be cut to preceed with the provision of technical assistance of the reactor/s.
 - Moreover, video presentation that exceeds the allotted file size of 300MB may not be included in the activity;




3. The five-minute video presentation will be played and focuses on the research results, conclusions, and recommendations.
4. The presenters are advised to follow the prescribed outline and content of the presentation below:

Outline	Content
Title of the Study (1 slide)	title of the study, researcher/s, affiliation, & Division Office
Introduction/Rationale/Background of the Study (1 slide)	Describe the problem or the issue that inspires the researcher/s to conduct the study.

Statement of the Problem (1-2 slides)	Enumerate the statement of the problem.
Theoretical/Conceptual Framework (1-2 slides)	Present the theoretical or conceptual framework being used in the study.
Methodology and Scope of the Study (1-2 slides)	Present the research design, methodology, respondents, research locale, and ethical consideration
Research Findings (1-7 slides)	Present the findings in each specific research question or objective. Use pictures to support your findings.
Conclusions and Recommendations (1-3 slides)	Brief conclusion synthesizing the findings. Specify recommendations based on findings.
References (1 slide)	In bullet form, present relevant references used in the study
Contact Details (1 slide)	Provide contact details of the researchers for possible replication of other research enthusiasts and attendees.
