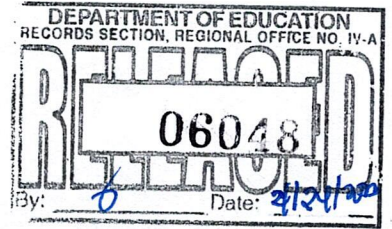

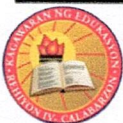
**REQUEST FOR THE PARTICIPATION OF THE TECHNICAL
