**MONITORING OF THE CONDUCT OF THE ONLINE  
COMPUTER-BASED NATIONAL LEARNING CAMP (NLC)  
ASSESSMENT FOR GRADES 7 AND 8 ENGLISH,  
SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS**

To **Schools Division Superintendents**  
**Regional Functional Division Chiefs**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 148, s. 2023, Conduct of the English, Science and Mathematics Assessment for the National Learning Camp Assessment, the Bureau of Education Assessment-Education Assessment Division (BEA-EAD) in collaboration with the RO, SDOs and Schools will administer an online computer-based National Learning Camp Assessment to all **Grade 7 and 8** public school learners for School Year 2022-2023.
2. The objective of this monitoring is to ensure that the online computer - based test administration (Pre-test) is implemented based on the standards/requirements and determine issues and concerns for the provision of technical assistance.
3. The testing window for the **Pre-test** is from **June 21 to July 7, 2023** to Grades 7 and 8 learners (SY 2022-2023).
4. The Regional Monitoring Team is composed of the Functional Division Chiefs, Education Program Supervisors, Senior Education Program Specialists and Education Program Specialists. The said team shall monitor the SDO/School Testing Centers for at least **2** days only from **June 21 to July 7, 2023**.
5. The Monitoring Officials and schools are expected to comply with **R.A. 6713, the Code of Conduct and Ethical Standards for Public Officials and Employees**, especially Section 7d. *“Public Officials and employees shall not solicit or accept, directly or indirectly, any gift, gratuity, favor, entertainment, loan, or anything of monetary value from any person in the course of their official duties or in connection with any operation being regulated by, or any transaction which may be affected by the functions of their office.”* And, Section 4 of Article VIII under Code of Ethics For Professional Teachers states that *“A teacher shall not accept favours or gifts from learners, their parents or others in their behalf in exchange for requested concessions, especially if undeserved.”*






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6. It is highly encouraged that the Regional Monitoring Officials exhaust all means possible to cover all public schools testing centers.
