**CONDUCT OF THE ENGLISH, SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS
ASSESSMENT FOR THE NATIONAL LEARNING CAMP (NLC)**

To **Schools Division Superintendents**
Regional and Division Testing Coordinators
Regional and Division Information Technology Officers

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum DM-OUCT-2023-148, Conduct of the English, Science and Mathematics Assessment for the National Learning Camp (NLC), the Bureau of Education Assessment-Education Assessment Division (BEA-EAD) will administer an online computer-based National Assessment for **Grades 7 and 8** public school learners for School Year 2022-2023.
2. The study on the effectiveness of the learning intervention will be based on the test administration results (Pre-test and Post-test).
3. The testing window for the **Pre-test** is from **June 21 to July 7, 2023** for Grades 7 and 8 learners (SY 2022-2023) and **Post-test** will be conducted on **August 2023** for Grades 8-9 learners (SY 2023-2024).
4. Schools Division Testing Coordinators are required to submit the List of Division Testing Centers to the Regional Testing Coordinator **on or before June 16, 2023**, via this link bit.ly/ROIVA_ListofTestingCtrs_ITOs.


