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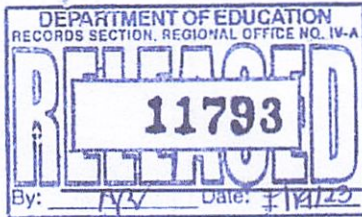
**ADVISORY ON THE CONCENTRATION TRAINING FOR

## **CONCENTRATION TRAINING FOR CALABARZON ATHLETES FOR THE 2023 PALARONG PAMBANSA**

To: **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. To ensure a competitive TEAM CALABARZON for the 2023 Palarong Pambansa on July 31 to August 5, 2023, in Marikina City, a live-in concentration training for Region IV-A CALABARZON athletes shall be conducted on July 17-23, 2023 in different Schools Division Offices.
2. All Division Sports Officers are instructed to bring their athletes in specific events to the designated coach and ensure that the athletes are properly handed over to the said coach.
3. Concerned Schools Division Offices are requested to provide accommodation in their selected schools to those athletes, assistant coaches, and chaperons coming from other divisions and to the whole team. All participants are also advised to bring their own mattresses, beddings, and food utensils.
4. The Official Coaches should prepare a Training Program to serve as reference by the Monitoring Team. The training should develop utmost discipline as expected from athletes. Included therein is the practice of Greetings (saludo or yell) for the Opening Program of the event. A video recording will be provided for such purpose.
5. The Regional Focals for Sports with the Division Sports Officers are directed to conduct the monitoring of the concentration training on July 17-23, 2023, and should take note of issues and concerns in need of immediate attention addressed to the Regional Director.
6. Travel expenses of athletes, coaches, assistant coaches, and chaperons going to and from the training venue shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Food allowances for athletes during the 7-day concentration training will be downloaded to their respective Schools Division Offices.
7. Enclosed hereto are: List of Selected Athletes, Coaches, Assistant Coaches, and Chaperons; List of playing venues; Calendar of Activities Monitoring Team and suggested monitoring template for reference.





