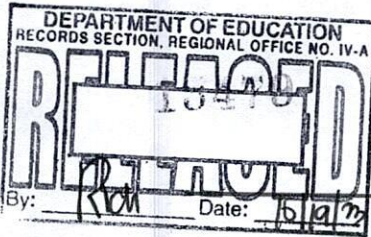

Greetings from **MATH-Inic Philippines**, the Philippine partner of the **Institute for the Advancement of Vedic Mathematics (IAVM)**, a British registered charity dedicated to the promotion of Vedic Mathematics worldwide!

Attached is the invitation of Mr. James Glover, chair of the IAVM to participate in the **3<sup>rd</sup> International Vedic Mathematics Olympiad (IVMO 2023)** to be held on Nov 25, 2023.

The IVMO is an international competition in speed, problem-solving, mathematical acumen, and Vedic Maths techniques.

Our participants in the first two editions of the IVMO did the Philippines proud. In IVMO 2021, our Mathletes competed against eight other countries, landing on the top in four out of five categories, and garnering 35 gold, 70 silver, and 107 bronze awards—over 75% of the total awards given.

In last year's IVMO 2022, our learners displayed their math mastery over their counterparts from 10 other countries, winning 152 gold, 329 silver and 530 bronze awards, which is almost 90% of all the awards given. Filipinos also scored highest in five of the six categories and took 18 of the 20 top three places.

Judging from the performance of our learners in these events, we can say that Vedic Math—with its emphasis on making Math fun and easy—is an ideal supplement to our current Math curriculum.


Participation in this event is purely voluntary and since it will be held on a Saturday, it will not disrupt classes.
