# SUPPORT TO THE PHILIPPINE STATISTICS AUTHORITY (PSA) REGION IV-A CALABARZON'S PHILIPPINE IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM (PhilSys) MOBILE REGISTRATION CAMPAIGN

To: **Schools Division Superintendents** All Others Concerned

- 1. The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) is mandated as the primary agency in implementing RA 11055, otherwise known as the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys). This system aims to provide free, valid, and centralized identification with the objective of accelerating financial inclusion, increased access to social and economic oppurtunities, and the transition to digital transactions that are secured, affordable, and efficient.
- 2. The PSA's commitment is to register and issue PhilID cards to ninety-two (92) million Filipinos by December 31, 2023 and with the Provincial Statistical Offices, mobile registration activities have been conducted to accommodate all unregistered individuals.
- 3. Also, as a PSA partner, this Office encourages all public and private schools to support this activity through information dissemination.



Recognizing the integral role of the youth in nation-building, the Department of Education (DepEd) offices, schools, and personnel are enjoined to participate in the nationwide promotion of the National ID Program or the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys). The campaign, titled "PhilSys: Ang Digital ID para sa Makabagong Pilipinas," envisions a sustainable, digital, and inclusive society where no Filipino is left behind.

Republic Act No. 11055, otherwise known as the Philippine Identification System Act, mandates the establishment of a central national identification system for all citizens and resident aliens in the Philippines. The PhilSys aims to provide free, valid, and centralized identification with the objective of accelerating financial inclusion, increased access to social and economic opportunities, and the transition to digital transactions that are secure, affordable, and efficient.

For 2021, the goal of the PhilSys program is to register 50 to 70 million individuals. The online Step 1 Registration, which includes the collection of demographic information and appointment setting for Step 2, was made available in 2021. This step utilizes digital networks to ensure the health and safety of the registrants amid the COVID-19 pandemic. Consequently, Step 2 Registration will involve the validation of supporting documents and capturing of biometric information, such as fingerprints, iris scans, and front facing photographs at registration centers. Finally, Step 3 will involve the issuance of the PhilSys Number (PSN) and the physical ID (PhilID).
