To **Schools Division Superintendents**

- 1. 





DepEd's 236, 000 Trees - A Christmas Gift for the Children


- 1. School heads shall refrain from collecting contributions from learners, teachers and other stakeholders. They will also ensure that proper planning and implementation of asynchronous classes takes place.
- 2. In the event that there is no available planting area within the school, the school head shall coordinate with Local Government Unit (LGU) in identifying the National Greening Program Site and shall ensure that the site is prepared prior to the date of tree planting.
- Bamboo shall be the primary material for the tree guard, in the absence of bamboo, wood can be a suitable replacement provided that the design will be followed.
