 - d. Tax Identification Number (TIN)-(for MOSPA Finalists only)
6. The MOSPA will be officially announced during the Gabi ng Pagpapahalaga on February 29, 2024 at 7:00 in the evening at Paseo Premiere Hotel, Santa Rosa City. Meanwhile, the MOCJ will be declared during the Awarding of Winners in Individual and Group Events on March 2, 2024 at the respective venues. Finalists in both searches shall wear *Filipiniana or Barong Tagalog* attire.
7. Travel, food, incidental and other expenses of the participants relative to this activity shall be charged against school local fund or MOOE, whichever




