REGIONAL TRAINING OF DIVISION TRAINERS AND SCHOOL LEADERS ON THE MATATAG CURRICULUM IMPLEMENTATION

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. In support to MATATAG Agenda of the Department, specifically, on making the curriculum relevant to produce competent and job-ready, responsible, and active citizens and on giving support to teachers to teach better, this Office, through the Human Resource Development-National Educators Academy of the Philippines in the Region (HRDD-NEAP R) in collaboration with the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will conduct the Regional Training of Division Trainers and School Leaders on the MATATAG Curriculum Implementation for Kindergarten, Grades 1, 4, and 7 on April 15-19, 2024 at venues to be disseminated in a separate memorandum.
- 2. This activity focuses on providing professional development support for teachers and school leaders ensuring that they have in-depth understanding of the general shape of the MATATAG curriculum. Specifically, it aims to equip them with the necessary knowledge, skills, and competencies to effectively implement the said curriculum.
- 3. Participants in this activity are the following:
 - a. CID Chief Education Supervisors;
 - b. Division Education Program Supervisors and select Public Schools District Supervisors with learning area specializations;
 - c. Division IPEd focal persons;
 - d. Select School Heads, Head Teachers, and Master Teachers with aligned learning area specializations; and
 - e. SGOD Chief/HRD Specialist (who will serve as program manager of the Division Training of Trainers)

- 4. To ensure quality of training, all participants who will serve as Division Trainers shall have the following qualifications:
 - a. a master's degree aligned with learning area specialization;
 - teaching experience related to Kindergarten, Grade 1, Grade 4, or Grade 7;
 - c. trainings attended and conducted relevant to the learning area assigned; and
 - d. at least Very Satisfactory rating in IPCRF (FY 2023)
- 5. The Regional Trainers and the breakdown of participants per SDO are attached to this Memorandum. Official endorsement of participants signed by the Schools Division Superintendent shall be submitted to neap.calabarzon@deped.gov.ph using the template attached to this Memorandum. Endorsed participants per SDO shall register through bit.ly/4A_RTOT_MATATAG on or before February 29, 2024. They shall also upload their PRC Curriculum Vitae with updated PRC ID to the same link. Template can be accessed through bit.ly/PRCCV.
- 6. Final lists of Division trainers/participants for Kindergarten, Grades 1, 4, and 7 per learning area and the training matrices shall be disseminated in a separate memorandum.
- 7. Board and lodging and travel expenses of the Regional Program Management team members and participants and the training supplies expenses shall be charged against the 2024 HRD Funds allotted for MATATAG Curriculum training, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
