ORIENTATION ON THE OKY PHILIPPINES PERIOD TRACKER APP

To Schools Division Superintendents

- Relative to the letter from UNICEF and Plan International dated February 21, 2024¹, it is informed that an Orientation on the OKy Philippines Period Tracker App for DepEd CALABARZON will be conducted on March 20-21, 2024, at Wynwood Hotel 45 San Miguel Avenue, Ortigas Center, Barangay San Antonio, Pasig City.
- 2. The orientation aims to introduce the OKy Philippines Period Tracker App to facilitate downloading of the app, distribute promotional materials, find ways how to integrate the App as a key resource in the implementation of the health curriculum, and create a division-wide action plan cascading the App.
