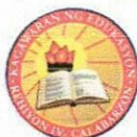

**SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION IN THE SECOND  
PHASE OF TRAINING ON MENTORING FUTURE  
LEADERS FOR NATION-BUILDING**

To **Schools Division Superintendents**  
(Batangas Province, Batangas City, Biñan City, Cavite Province,  
Lucena City, Sto. Tomas City)

1. Security Bank Foundation, Inc. (SBFI) is offering the second run of the training course on Mentoring Future Leaders for Nation-Building to school principals from schools with SBFI Building. This is a 3-year training program in partnership with the Ateneo Center of Educational Development. It includes the international Certificate in Education Studies in Leadership (CESL) modules developed by the University of Bristol (UoB), United Kingdom, and funded by the HEAD Foundation Singapore.
2. This Office, encourages qualified principals to apply for the program on or before May 3, 2024. Please refer to Annex A for the list of schools with SBFI buildings.
3. Applicants must have the following qualifications:
  - a. at least 7 years of service before retirement,
  - b. available and can commit to attending all in-person and online activities for three years, and
  - c. demonstrated resourcefulness in implementing context-based school transformation.
4. Should the school principal from the beneficiary schools did not meet the eligibility requirements, the Division may recommend qualified principals from other schools preferably foreseen as successor principals of the recipient school of SBFI.

The in-person training sessions are tentatively scheduled on July 8-12, 2024, and October 21-25, 2024 at Ateneo de Cebu, Mandaue City.
