

The Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Learning Resources (BLR) gathered feedback on the outcomes of the scoping activities organized in coordination with the National Book Development Board (NBDB) and by the Regional Offices (ROs) in the identification of Supplementary Learning Resources (SLRs).

As part of the ongoing efforts to promote literacy and enhance educational initiatives with the aim of creating a comprehensive reference of titles that have been scoped and evaluated by the SLR committees, this Office informs the field offices of the list of SLRs from the submitted consolidated Priority Lists of Regional Offices (ROs) on the recent scoping and evaluation activities conducted.

This also informs the field offices on the list of passed reading resources (RRs) for enrichment for the National Reading Program (NRP).

This list is the result of the evaluation process of RRs submitted during the *Invitation for the Submission of Reading Resources (RRs) for Enrichment for the National Reading Program (NRP)*. The RRs submitted were evaluated based on standardized criteria and guidelines ensuring the quality of reading resources that will enhance the effectiveness of the program and promote the development of strong reading skills among the target learners.

The category/type of RRs submitted and evaluated for this year include the following:

For Grade 1

- a. Storybooks for Emergent and Beginning Readers
- b. Wordless Picture Books
- c. Big Books
- d. Leveled Readers
- e. Serialized Reading Materials

For Grades 2 and 3

- a. Storybooks
- b. Story compilations (or children's story anthology)
- c. *Other materials for remediation and enrichment

The list of passed RRs are in support with the MATATAG Agenda to provide each classroom for every organized class with a set of titles in order for the teachers and learners to have engaging love for reading. This set of reading resources must have undergone quality assurance for it to be curriculum compliant, responsive to the needs, relevant to experiences, and meaningful in the development of foundational skills in reading.

These lists will serve as valuable references, without need for further evaluation, for identifying learning resources to expand the SLRs catalog on school libraries and library hubs and to ensure that all efforts lead in fostering a culture of reading and learning among our learners.

Attached is the list of SLRs based on the results of the market scoping activity conducted and the list of passed RRs for enrichment for the NRP.
