**PLANNING WORKSHOP, CONSULTATIVE AND

1. Relative to DepEd Order No. 123, s. 2015 entitled Guidelines on the Early Language Literacy and Numeracy (ELLN) Program: Professional Development Component and in support of the MATATAG Education Agenda and the National Learning Recovery Program, this Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will conduct the Early Language Literacy and Numeracy Regional Summit on the following schedule:

2. The activity aims to:
 - a. develop a series of activities to strengthen literacy and numeracy programs in the region;
 - b. promote and sustain a culture of reading in schools and even in the communities; and
 - c. upskill school heads and reading coordinators' capacity to provide technical assistance to the K to 3 teachers.






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3. Participants in this activity will be Division Supervisors in ELLN, Reading, Mathematics, and Division LR Personnel. Specific batches as well as Indicative Program of Activities will be announced through a separate issuance.

5. Participants shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53 s. 2003 entitled Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers. Likewise, non-teaching personnel, including management staff, shall be provided with Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and DBM Joint Circular No. 2 s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered.
6. Board and lodging of the identified participants shall be charged against ELLN program support funds, while expenses relative to travel will be charged against local funds, subject to existing auditing and accounting rules and regulations.
