PARTICIPATION AND INVITATION FOR THE SECOND CHILD PROTECTION E-LEARNING COURSE FOR EDUCATORS

To: **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. In reference to DepEd Memorandum OUOPS-2024-05-03636¹, this Office through the Field Technical Assistance Division, requests for the participation of interested educators under Region IV-A CALABARZON for the second Child Protection E-Learning Course.
