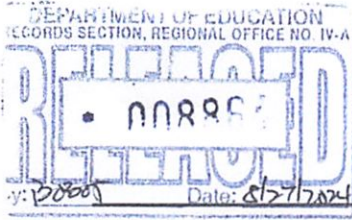

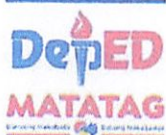

**TRAINING WORKSHOP ON CHILD PROTECTION  
COMMITTEE FUNCTIONALITY 2024**

To **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. In reference to DepEd Memorandum No. OUOPS 2024-05-01206<sup>1</sup>, this Office through the Field Technical Assistance Division, requests for participants in the aforementioned activity on **September 25-27, 2024**. The venue of the activity will be announced on a separate issuance.
