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
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AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE

PHILIPPINE GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING ASSOCIATION, INC. (Formerly: PHILIPPINE GUIDANCE AND PERSONNEL ASSOCIATION, INC.)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT WE, all of whom are of legal age, citizens and residents of the Philippines, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming non-stock, non-profit association under the Laws of the Philippine. (AS AMENDED ON March 22, 2016).

And We Hereby Certify:

First – That the name of said organization shall be known as the PHILIPPINEGUIDANCE AND COUNSELING ASSOCIATION, INC. (As amended on May 14, 1997);

Second - That the purposes for which the Association is organized are as follows:

- a. To improve the standards of guidance and personnel work;
- To promote and stimulate the exchange of professional experience through international, national, regional and/or local meetings;
