

**GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS FOR THE 2024 “ISANG BITUIN, ISANG
MITHIIN,”**

A NATIONAL PAROL MAKING COMPETITION

Theme: Harmonies of Hope: Illuminating Filipino Resilience

1. Eligibility

Open to students (high school and senior high) of public secondary schools under DepEd.

2. Criteria for Judging

Creativity and Originality	20%
Technical Skills & Craftsmanship	30%
Adherence to Theme	20%
Overall impact and aesthetic	20%
Online votes	10%

3. Mechanics

- 3.1 One (1) parol entry per Public secondary school under DepEd. This should be made by a maximum of four (4) officially enrolled students. Schools are not required. This is voluntary.
- 3.2 Each School Division should have one (1) parol entry for the National Parol Competition.
- 3.3 Innovation and Creativity: Encourage students to experiment with new materials, techniques, and forms while staying true to the traditional artistry of parol making.
- 3.4 Cultural Representation: Emphasize the importance of incorporating Filipino cultural elements, symbols, and traditions into the design, celebrating the richness of Filipino heritage.
- 3.5 Various Recycled Materials: Parols can be made from various materials that are recycled (EXCEPT PLASTIC) & endemic to their provinces, such as bamboo, coconut palm, etc.
- 3.6 Storytelling through Art: Each parol should tell a compelling story of resilience, hope, and community spirit, inspiring others with its message and design.
- 3.7 Two (2) feet in diameter with about 35% of the diameter in thickness (at its core). No STAND.
- 3.8 Lights are required however live fire & candles are not allowed.

- 3.9 It must be able to withstand any type of weather
- 3.10 Official entry of each division must have proper endorsement from the division head

4. Number of Entries

One (1) *parol* entry per Division Office made by a maximum of four officially enrolled (4) students

5. Requirements

The Secondary schools within the Division are encouraged to engage in an intercollegiate competition, wherein each school should submit its Parol entry, and the winning Parol will serve as the official entry of their respective Division office.

The pictures and names of the winners or official entries from the Division will be submitted via email to OP-SOSEC via **sosec.production@gmail.com**.

- 6. Participating schools must submit a brief description of the materials used, the inspiration behind their design, and the names of students who created the parol. A video documentation of how the parol was made should also be provided.

6.1 Video Documentation for the Online Parol Video Contest

- A. Orientation - Landscape
- B. Time - A maximum of 1 minute and 30 seconds (wrap up video of the creation process)
- C. Device - Phone Camera or SLR
- D. Storage - The *Flash Drive* or google drive should contain the following files:
 - Video Documentation of the creation process
 - Soft copy of the endorsement letter
 - Brief Description of the Parol Entry

- 7. **Endorsement Letter.** Printed and soft copies of Official Endorsement letters from their respective Schools Division Superintendent they represent are required upon submission of entries.
