REGIONAL IPED SUMMIT 2024: EMPOWERING INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES THROUGH EDUCATION AND VALUES RESTORATION

To Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. In support to MATATAG Agenda of the Department, specifically on making the curriculum relevant to produce competent and job-ready, responsible, and active citizens and on giving support to teachers to teach better, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will conduct the Regional IPEd Summit 2024: Empowering Indigenous Communities through Education and Values Restoration on November 18-20, 2024.
