CONSULTATIVE AND PLANNING CONFERENCE AND STRATEGIC DIRECTIONS FOR THE REGIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE, FESTIVAL OF TALENTS, AND SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY FAIR

To Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. Relative to the long term goal of cultivating talent in journalism, creative arts, and scientific inquiry to empower students, this Region, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will hold the Consultative And Planning Conference and Strategic Directions for the Regional Schools Press Conference, Festival of Talents, and Science and Technology Fair on October 29, 2024 at a venue that will be announced through a regional advisory.
- 2. This activity aims to:
 - a. develop a comprehensive action plan that outlines clear strategies, timelines, and responsibilities for preparing student participants in the Regional Schools Press Conference, Festival of Talents, and Science and Technology Fair, ensuring alignment with national competition standards:
 - b. outline clear strategies that address skill development areas for student participants, ensuring competitive performance in national events;
 - c. set specific timelines for the implementation of training programs and preparatory activities, ensuring timely readiness for the Regional Schools Press Conference, Festival of Talents, and Science and Technology Fair; and
 - d. assign clear responsibilities to key stakeholders, including school administrators, advisers, and coaches, to ensure coordinated efforts in student preparation.
- 3. Participants in this activity are Regional Office Top Management and CLMD Personnel, SDO Top Management (Schools Division Superintendent or Assistant SDS), Chief Education Supervisors of Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), and Education Program Supervisors who are Focal Persons of the Schools Press Conference, Festival of Talents, and Science and Technology Fair.
