CONTRACT OF SERVICE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This contract made and entered into by and between:

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION REGIONAL OFFICE IV-A CALABARZON, a component field office of the government entity known as the Department of Education organized under existing Philippine laws with office address at Gate 2, Karangalan Village, Cainta, Rizal and herein represented by its Regional Director, **ATTY. ALBERTO T. ESCOBARTE.** It shall be referred in this agreement as the **CLIENT.**

SUNRISE RIDGE CORPORATION (SOLESTE SUITES), a domestic corporation duly registered under the Philippine laws, with principal address at No. 193 Katipunan Avenue, Blue Ridge, Quezon City, represented herein by its Hotel Operations Manager, **BERNALIZA B. SANTOS**, hereinafter referred to as the **HOTEL COMPANY**.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the CLIENT needs the services of a hotel company who will provide food and hotel accommodation to the participants in the "OPTIMIZING WORKFLOW JUNCTION: NAVIGATING THE PROCESS INTERFACE CUM DIVISION PROCESS REVIEW" on December 2 to 4, 2024 to be conducted by the client.

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is SIXTY-NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED PESOS ONLY (PhP69,600.00);

WHEREAS, Section 53.9 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (R-IRR) of Republic Act 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act of 2003", allows an agency to resort to Small Value Procurement as alternative method of procurement where the amount involved does not exceed the threshold amount of One Million Pesos (Php1,000,000.00) as prescribed in Annex "H" thereof;

WHEREAS, the Request for Quotation (RFQ) was posted in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) on September 27, 2024, at the website of DepEd Region IV-A CALABARZON, and conspicuous bulletin board in the premises of DepEd Region IV-A CALABARZON on September 26, 2024 to September 30, 2024;

WHEREAS, RFOs were sent to at least three (3) prospective suppliers namely:

- 1. Sunrise Ridge Corporation (Soleste Suites);
- 2. Red Hotel, Inc.; and
- 3. BGISTS Development Corporation (Luxent Hotel).


WHEREAS, only one (1) supplier submitted its proposal; the SUNRISE RIDGE CORPORATION (SOLESTE SUITES) proposed in the amount of SIXTY-FOUR

THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS ONLY (PhP64,150.00). Thus, the Hotel Company is declared as the lone bidder

WHEREAS, after review and deliberation on the proposal, **SUNRISE RIDGE CORPORATION (SOLESTE SUITES)** complied with the requirements and declared as the Single Calculated and Responsive Quotation (SCRQ);

WHEREAS, the Client invited Bids for the Procurement of food and hotel accommodation of the participants in the "OPTIMIZING WORKFLOW JUNCTION: NAVIGATING THE PROCESS INTERFACE CUM DIVISION PROCESS REVIEW" on December 2 to 4, 2024 and has accepted the bid/quotation of the Hotel Company for food and hotel accommodation in the sum of SIXTY-FOUR THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS ONLY (PhP64,150.00). (Hereinafter called "the Contract Price").

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises of the mutual covenants and provisions hereafter set forth, the parties hereto have agreed and do hereby mutually agree as follows:

Section 1 Responsibilities of the Hotel Company

The Hotel Company shall:

- 1. Provide food and hotel accommodation on December 2 to 4, 2024 to the guaranteed number of participants of the **Client**;
- Maintain that all of the services to be performed under or pursuant to this contract shall be of the standard and quality which prevail among similar businesses and organizations of superior knowledge and skill engaged in providing similar services under the same or similar circumstances; and
- 3. Do such other acts which are necessary in the performance of the above functions as well as those obligations arising from this contract.
- 4. Provide with personnel to:
 - 4.1 maintain cleanliness in the function hall, restrooms, sleeping quarters, hallway, pantry, and dining area;
 - 4.2 provide a backdrop for the activity; and tarpaulin display at the Project Site, not to exceed 3"x4"; optional for Projects not exceeding 5 days (COA Circ. 2013-004)
 - 4.3 respond to safety and security requirements of the government;
 - 4.4 appropriate and sufficient parking area for VIPs and guests; and
 - 4.5 24-hour security, front-desk and housekeeping services

Section 2 Responsibilities of the Client

The Client shall:

- 1. Pay the **Hotel Company** the guaranteed number of participants
- Charged or billed the total amount of SIXTY-FOUR THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS ONLY (PhP64,150.00) for the whole duration of the event;
- Exercise strict discipline, close supervision and exclusive control and administration over its participants in accordance



with law, ordinances and pertinent government rules and regulations as well as the rules and policies laid down by the **Hotel Company** on the matter;

Section 3 Terms of Payment

The **Client** binds itself to pay the **Hotel Company** within thirty (30) days after the conclusion of the training/seminar. The **Hotel Company** hereby understands that the focal person must be the one responsible for the immediate processing of payments.

Section 4 Specification of the Services

The Hotel Company shall provide for the following:

a. The meals shall be:

- **a.1** Complete meal (breakfast, AM snacks, lunch, PM snacks and dinner) to the **30** participants on December 2, 2024, and to the **7** participants on December 3 and 4, 2024 of the Client;
- **a.2** First meal is **breakfast** of December 2, 2024 and last meal is **PM snacks** of December 4, 2024;
- **a.3** Served by any type of buffet with stand-by waiters during breakfast, lunch and dinner;
- **a.4** with unlimited coffee, purified drinking water, tea or chocolate drink and candies, with assistance of stand-by waiters

b. The Lodging shall be:

- **b.1** at least two (2) single/double sharing rooms with single beds only;
- **b.2** no mattress on the floor;
- **b.3** with 24-hour hot and cold shower and clean beddings, rooms and restroom

c. The Function Hall and Facilities shall be:

- **c.1** well-lighted and well ventilated;
- **c.2** with sufficient space to accommodate at least 30 participants in a conference set-up;
- **c.3** with available audio-visual equipment with stand-by personnel to assist in the operation of:
 - c.3.1 Two (2) LCD projectors and screen;
 - c.3.2 One (1) whiteboard with marker/s and erasers
 - **c.3.3** Three (3) serviceable and wireless microphones; complete set of sound system and **6** extension cords for laptops;
 - c.3.4 Podium/lectern, etc.
- c.4 with fast and reliable internet connection;
- **c.5** with at least two (2) tables for the secretariat (registration)
- c.6 without pillars in the middle of the function room.

Section 5 Use of Hotel Parking Space

The **Hotel Company** shall allow the use of its parking space to the participants free of charge.



Section 6 Termination of Contract

Any party may terminate this Contract based on the grounds provided and after compliance with Annex "I" of the 2016 Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 9184.

Section 7 Venue of Action

The parties shall make every effort to resolve amicably and by mutual consultation any or all disputes or differences arising between the Parties in connection with the implementation of this Contract. Should such dispute not be resolved amicably, it shall be submitted to arbitration in the Philippines according to the provisions of Presidential Decree No. 242 and Executive Order No. 292. Provided, however, that by mutual agreement, the parties may agree in writing to resort to other alternative modes of dispute resolution.

Section 8 Capacity and Authorization

Each of the parties to this contract hereby represents and warrants to the other that it is duly authorized and empowered to execute, deliver and perform this contract and that such action does not conflict with or violate any provision of law, regulation, policy, contract, deed of trust or other instrument to which it is a party or by which it is bound and that this contract constitutes a valid and binding obligation between the parties.

Section 9 Other conditions of the contract

- a. In case of damage to the property of the participants of the Client caused by negligence of the personnel of the Hotel Company, the Hotel Company shall be liable for the damages;
- b. Necessary medical services and facilities shall be the responsibility and for the account of the **Hotel Company**; and
- c. The **Hotel Company** shall cause the notarization of this contract.
