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**FY 2024 4TH QUARTER REGIONAL DRRM CONFERENCE**

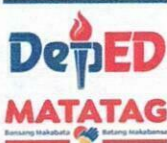

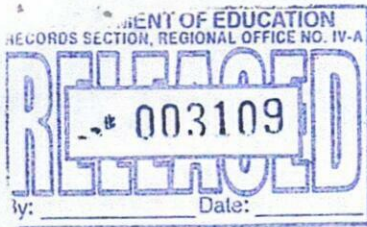

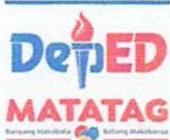
**FY 2024 REGIONAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND
