UNIVERSAL PREVENTION CURRICULUM (UPC) FOR SUBSTANCE ABUSE CALABARZON RE-ECHO TRAINING OF MODULE 5: SCHOOL-BASED PREVENTION INTERVENTIONS

To Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. The Department of Education Regional Officer IV-A CALABARZON through the Education Support Services Division-School Health Section will conduct this Training on November 18-22, 2024 at a venue to be announced on a separate advisory.
- 2. The training goals are to provide an overview of the opportunities that schools provide for drug prevention; develop participants' understanding of matching students' developmental stages to prevention programs and strategies; assist participants in getting started in schools; provide an overview of the principles of effective and ineffective prevention practice in school settings-of what works and what does not work; teach participants how to negotiate registries of evidence-based practice and select the prevention course that is right for their school; provide an overview of issues pertaining to implementation fidelity and adaptation; and develop participants' understanding of effective drug prevention policies and whole school prevention programs.
- 3. Participants are the Schools Division Medical Officers, National Drug Education Program Focal Person, EPS for Values or Registered Guidance Counselor/Guidance Counselor or School Head. They should have completed Curriculum 1 (Introduction to Prevention Science) or commit to undertake the Curriculum within a year through the UPC Manager's and Supervisor's Course (Online Instructor Led) UPC 1. To join, apply as a member of the International Society of Substance Use Professionals (ISSUP): <u>www.issup.net</u>.
- 4. The list of participants and program are attached. Participants are to register before October 24, 2024 (Thursday) via <u>https://bit.ly/R4A-UPC5registration</u>. Participants are encouraged to wear corporate attire with agency ID and to bring a laptop to be used during the event.
