YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH POSTER-MAKING MECHANICS

1. Background

In promoting School Sports for Mental Health Program, the Education Support Services Division through Partnership and Linkages, Youth Formation Division, and Region IV-A Sports Officers are conducting a Poster- Making Activity.

The objective of the activity is typically to promote awareness of the benefits of sports for mental health programs. This is also to comply with the OM- OUOPS-10-1973, considering the implementation of after-school sports programs for all learners who are interested in learning and engaging in the different sports events and enjoy the benefits of sports as an intervention in the DepEd mental health program.

2. Participants

The activity is open to all Grades 9, 10, and 11 students enrolled in any DepEd duly recognized public and private schools. There shall be one YFD Chaperone **PER ONE DIVISION** participant of the poster-making activity.

3. Scope / Theme

The work of art should portray the benefits of sports for mental health. and should be in line with the theme: **Promoting Schools Sports for Mental Health Program.**

4. Specification

Please take note of the following requirements to ensure that the artwork satisfies the specifications of the activity.

- 4.1 The poster should be on a 15" x 20" illustration board.
- 4.2 Participants may use any medium of his/her choice, (e.g. oil paste, crayon, and watercolor)
- 4.3 The poster must be described in one or two sentences.

 The description must be handwritten on a ½ A4 bond paper and posted at the back of the artwork with the following information
 - 4.3.1 Name of Learner
 - 4.3.2 Contact Number
 - 4.3.3 School/Division
 - 4.3.4 Division
 - 4.3.5 Name of Chaperone

5. Criteria

5.1 Adherence to the Scope and Objective	25%
5.2 Creativity and Originality	30%
5.3 Composition	25%
5.4 Visual Impact	20%
Total	100 %

6. Uploading on the Official Facebook Page

All artworks are requested to be uploaded by the chaperone together with the student artist's name, school, and division on the official Facebook page of their respective division.

7. Recognition and Awards

Selection of the top ten (10) artworks that achieve the highest score shall be considered the **Ten Best Youth Schools Sports for Mental Program.** The recognition is expected to be awarded during the next Youth Formators activity.

8. Exhibit of Art works

Finished artwork shall be displayed in the working area and the student artist must be ready to describe the artwork in case of questions from visitors and other audiences.

9. Copyright

The organizer has the right to publish and own the submitted artwork.

10. Submission of Artworks

10.1 The submission of the finished artworks will be one hour before the end of the program and shall be submitted to Education Support Services Division of DepEd Region IV-A.
