IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR THE 2025 CALABARZON LEARNING RESOURCE EXPO (CLRE)

To **Schools Division Superintendents**

- 1. The Department of Education Region IV-A, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD)-Learning Resource Management Section (LRMS), announces the conduct of the 2025 CALABARZON Learning Resources Expo (CLRE) on December 16-19, 2024, at a venue to be announced in a separate memorandum.
- 2. The CLRE is a significant platform for Schools Division Offices (SDOs) across CALABARZON to showcase and evaluate a range of high-quality, innovative, and inclusive learning resources that align with the new curriculum. This year's expo will highlight materials that strengthen numeracy, literacy, and critical thinking across all key stages. Additionally, the expo includes resources tailored to the needs of SPED, IPED, ALS, and Madrasah, promoting inclusivity and addressing diverse learning needs.
- Implementing Guidelines for the said activity is attached in Enclosure 1.
- 4. The participants in this activity are the SDSs, ASDSs, and SDO Learning Resource Team. SDSs, ASDSs, and CID Chiefs must come only on December 18, 2024. Meanwhile, the SDO Learning Resource Team shall attend on December 16-19, 2024.
- 5. Travel expenses and per diem of the participants shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Implementing Guidelines for the 2025 CALABARZON LEARNING RESOURCE EXPO (CLRE)

1. Purpose and Scope

The CLRE aims to collect a rich array of innovative educational learners' and teachers' materials, such as modules, self-learning kits, assessment materials, activity sheets, and other nonprint learners' material in all key stages, for use in all classrooms.

With the availability of these varied supplementary learning resources, it is hoped that teachers can differentiate and engage learners who need enrichment and assistance in learning the skills, values, and knowledge in all disciplines using these educational materials.

For clarity, the following definitions are presented.


Educational materials are LRs that adhere to the new curriculum standard and can be used by both teachers and learners in the deployment of the teaching-learning process.

Educational materials are any print or non-print, text-based or non-text-based, materials, devices, tools, equipment, and other media aligned with the new curriculum used as primary bases or as a supplement to teaching and learning processes.

Learning Resources (LRs) are any digital or non-digital educational resource with a learning purpose. These resources are designed to be used directly by the learners and/or integrated into teacher-developed lesson plans.

Teaching Resources (TRs) are any educational resource digital or non-digital that supports teachers in curriculum development, delivery, and pedagogy or teacher trainers in the delivery of professional development programs.

- Kaagapay sa Pagtuturo: Outstanding Teaching Resource-Awarded to LRs that effectively support teachers in curriculum implementation and teaching excellence.
- Dangal Kamalayan: Innovation in Educational Media-Celebrates innovative resources—both text-based and multimedia—that bring the curriculum to life for learners.
- Pambihirang Sipi: Outstanding Print Learning Material-Acknowledges print materials of high quality that effectively supplement or serve as core resources.
- Balangkas ng Tagumpay: Curriculum-Aligned Learning Resource - Honors LRs that are meticulously aligned with the new curriculum standards, promoting comprehensive learning.

• Parangal sa Makabagong Kagamitan: Best Digital Learning Tool -Recognizes digital learning tools that enhance educational delivery and accessibility.

5. Requirements for the Booth

- 5.1. Physical Requirements
 - 5.1.1 LRs must be creatively showcased through various presentation formats.
 - 5.1.2 Only the LRs submitted to the region for quality assurance will be displayed in the booth.
 - 5.1.3 Each SDO is free to use any device/equipment/gadget to showcase their LRs.
 - 5.1.4 No tarpaulin to be used but backdrop is allowed.
 - 5.1.5 Each booth must have one (1) representative to man the booth during the showcase.
- 5.1 Size: Floor Area 1m x1m, Minimum Height 2m
- 5.2 Contents
 - 5.3.1 The LRs to be submitted must be quality-assured by the SDO and utilized by the learners.
 - 5.3.2 SDO shall submit the **best 3 LRs** of each type of LR.


