CALL FOR SUBMISSION OF RESEARCH ABSTRACTS FOR THE 2025 REGIONAL CONFERENCE OF BASIC EDUCATION RESEARCHERS

To **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. In promotion of the sustained culture of research and to showcase significant findings of the studies, this Office, through the Regional Research Committee (RRC) calls for submission of research proposals from educational leaders, instructional leaders, teachers, non-teaching personnel, and other research practitioners from public and private basic education institutions in the region. This is also in preparation for the proposed 2025 Regional Conference of Basic Education Researchers.
2. Researcher-grantees under the BERF Cycles who have not yet presented in previous regional research conferences are also expected to participate. Other interested parties may also join the event as their new learning venue.
3. The researcher/s should pre-identify their paper based on the priority research themes indicated in the **Basic Education Research Agenda (BERA)**, namely: **Teaching and Learning, Governance, Human Resource Development, and Child Protection**, with consideration as well of the **Cross-Cutting Themes: Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM), Gender and Development (GAD) and Inclusive Education**.
4. The entries must be completed research papers in SY 2022-2023, SY 2023-2024 and part of SY 2024-2025. The findings from the identified research themes should lead to evidence-based initiatives for providing access to comprehensive basic education, enhancing educational quality, and ensuring effective, transparent, and engaged governance. Entries that do not follow the specified structure and that are irrelevant to the research agenda will not be accepted.
5. The research abstracts shall be submitted to the Regional Office through <https://tinyurl.com/CERConAbstracts> on or before **January 31, 2025** using a code as the File Name following this format: Division Code_Research Agenda Code_Research Number. For example, from the table in the next page, the code **ANT_TAL_0001** means "Research No. 0001 from SDO Antipolo City under Teaching and Learning Theme"



6. The research abstracts should not exceed 200 -250 words containing the following:
 - a. **Purpose** refers to the objectives of the research
 - b. **Methodology** includes the research design, sampling and sample size, data collection methods, and statistical tools used in the study.
 - c. **Findings** contain data analysis and discussion.
 - d. **Conclusions and Recommendations** include the significant results of the research and recommendation.
 - e. **Keywords** consists of a listing of keywords that will facilitate the search for the research title.
7. All other details and updates relative to this Activity shall be announced in separate issuance.
