RECOMMENDING THE APPROVAL OF THE AGENCY-TO-AGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN DEPED REGION IV-A CALABARZON AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (TESDA) FOR THE CONDUCT OF TRAINING ON TRAINERS METHODOLOGY LEVEL I (TM I) FOR SHS-TVL TEACHERS

WHEREAS, this training aims to equip SHS-TVL teachers with the necessary knowledge, attitudes, values, and skills in accordance with the prevailing standards in the Technical-Vocational Education and Training (TVET) sector. It compasses competencies required of a technical-vocational trainer to perform the tasks based on TESDA's Training Regulation in the following areas:

WHEREAS, the Agency-to-Agency agreement with TESDA for the conduct of Training on Trainers Methodology Level I (TM1) for SHS-TVL Teachers on October 15, 2024 to October 30, 2024 and November 18, 2024 to December 13, 2024 has an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the amount **ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE PESOS (Php1,275,295.00)**. WHEREAS, pursuant to the Consolidated Guidelines for the Alternative Methods of Procurement, particularly paragraphs (b) and (c) of item V(D)(5), Annex "H" of the R-IRR of RA No. 9184 a Memorandum of Agreement may be entered into between the procuring entity and the servicing agency subject to the following conditions and process:
