 - c. updated curriculum vitae/resume;
 - d. Landbank (savings or current account number if available); and
 - e. Tax Identification Number (TIN)-(for MOSPA Finalists only).

The finalists in the search for the MOCJ and MOSPA are cordially invited to attend the Gabi ng Pagpapahalaga on February 13, 2025 at 4:00 in the afternoon at a venue that will be announced through a separate issuance. Finalists in both searches shall wear *Formal Wear or Evening Attire (Ex.: long gown for women and coat and tie for men)*.



