Regional Memorandum No. 137 s. 2025

JURY OF APPEALS RULES 2025

REGION IV-A CALABARZON

To **Schools Division Superintendents Technical Management and Administration Committee**

- 1. This relates to Regional Memorandum No. 60, s. 2025, on the conduct of the 2025 Regional Athletic Association Meet (RAAM) on February 28 to March 8, 2025, in Rizal Province and Antipolo City. To ensure the smooth and fair conduct of the RAAM 2025, the Jury of Appeals Committee provided the rules of procedures and guidelines for resolving disputes, protests and appeals.
- 2. Protest involving questions of law and/or interpretations of rules and guidelines shall be put in writing, signed by the coach and the head of the delegation. It should be submitted to the Tournament Director (TD) within one (1) hour immediately after the conclusion of the match in protest. Protests pertaining to concerns before the game must be communicated immediately to the TD, otherwise, it shall be considered moot and academic.

The TD shall decide within one (1) hour upon receipt of the protest.

- 3. All protests must be supported with the necessary evidence and attachments. Only official photo and/or video recordings will be considered as evidence.
- 4. The decision of the TD shall be appealable to the Jury of Appeals.
- 5. Appeal to the written Decision of the TD with all its supporting documents must be filed with the Games Executive and Administration Committees (GEAC).
- 6. GEAC shall refer the appeal within one (1) hour after receipt with the complete attachments, to the Jury of Appeals.
- 7. Only questions of law particularly those involving interpretation of the rules and guidelines are appealable to the Jury of Appeals.

8. The Jury of Appeals shall decide within forty-eight (48) hours upon receipt of the written appeal. The decision made by the Jury is final, irrevocable, and executory.
