### SUBMISSION OF THIRD-PARTY CONTENT INVENTORY IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF LEARNING RESOURCES TO BE PRINTED, UPLOADED TO THE DEPED WEBSITE, PORTAL, AND OTHER DISTANCE LEARNING PLATFORMS

#### To Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. In reference to the Department of Education (DepEd) Memorandum OM-CT-2025-143 dated February 17, 2025, regarding the use of third-party content in the development of learning resources (LRs) to be printed, uploaded to the DepEd website, portal, and other distance learning platforms, this Office directs all Schools Division Offices (SDOs) in the region to comply with the prescribed guidelines and submission requirements.
- 2. DepEd, in collaboration with the Filipinas Copyright Licensing Society, Inc. (FILCOLS), ensures adherence to Republic Act No. 8047 by properly managing and licensing learning resources for public schools. As such, all SDOs are required to submit the following documents requesting copyright permission:
  - a. Inventory of Third-Party Contents (Excel format)
  - b. Signed Inventory of Third-Party Contents
  - c. Digital Files of LRs with Third-Party Contents

However, only Rio Alma is willing to show himself before the public as the person Virgilio S. Almario. Bob Ong prefers to be anonymous and is known only to his publisher. Remuneration (or payment) for reusing their works belongs to them solely. Patricio N. Abinales and Ateneo Press share copyright ownership as expressed in the author's publishing contract. This means

	that the remuneration (or payment) for reusing Abinales's work is shared with his publisher.
