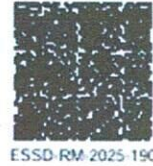

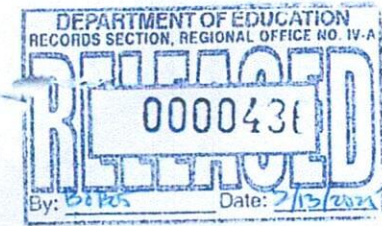

To **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. The Department of Education Region IV-A CALABARZON, through the Education Support Services Division, announces the schedule of activities attached hereto for Fiscal Year 2025 related to Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM), Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation (CCAM), Peacebuilding, and Education in Emergencies (EiE) plans, programs, projects, and activities.
2. These initiatives aim to enhance implementation mechanisms, ensure better coordination, and optimize resource utilization for greater impact.
3. Schools Division DRRM program focal persons are advised to facilitate the conduct of Division Climate Change Caravans (summits or conferences), the Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED), and other similar drills.
4. Focal persons are also expected to monitor and evaluate Comprehensive School Safety and DRRM program implementation in schools. Additionally, must provide a report on the obligation and utilization of the DRRM fund, as well as the downloaded disaster response program support funds.
5. Expenses for logistics, board and lodging, travel, and other incidental costs shall be charged to DRRM local funds, subject to existing auditing and accounting rules and regulations.
