DEVELOPMENT OF STRATEGIES ON TRACKING BASIC EDUCATION DATA USING TECHNOLOGIES

To Schools Division Superintendents Select RO Personnel

- 1. Relative to the Key Result Area (KRA) on Data Management, this office through Policy, Planning and Research Division (PPRD) will facilitate virtual activity on the **Development of Mechanism on Tracking Basic Education Data Using Technology** with Senior Education Program Specialists (SEPs) for Planning and Research and Planning Officers on April 28-30, 2025.
- 2. This activity aims to:
 - develop and implement a technology-driven mechanism that significantly improves the accuracy and timeliness of basic education data collection, specifically for ALS learners, OSY, and OSC, addressing the limitations of existing systems like ALS 2.0 M&E and LIS.
 - utilize technological tools to effectively locate and gather essential data on marginalized learners within the CALABARZON region, thereby improving their identification and ensuring their inclusion in basic education programs.
 - establish a sustainable data tracking mechanism that provides education leaders in CALABARZON with readily accessible, reliable, and actionable data, enabling them to make informed decisions that contribute to improved educational outcomes and the realization of Education for All.
- 3. Participants in this activity are the Schools Division Office SEPS for Planning and Research, Planning Officers, SDO and RO Education Program Supervisors of ALS and Kinder, and PPRD personnel as facilitator and secretariat.
