



3. promote a culture of collaboration across schools, empowering teachers to share

knowledge and learn from one another; and
4. align collaborative practices with DepEd's goals for improving quality, equity, and
efficiency in basic education.

In this regard, the Regional Offices, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), are requested to identify eight (8) Education Program Supervisors/School Heads/Special Curricular Programs Focal Persons to participate in the series of activities (see Enclosure 1 on Distribution of Participants). The names of the participants shall be endorsed by the Regional Director to BLD-SID through email address at bld.sid@deped.gov.ph (see Enclosure 2: Template for the Matrix of Participants) on or before May 26, 2025, 5:00PM. There shall be the same set of participants for the development and finalization stages to ensure continuity of the work flow. However, for the validation stage, there shall be another set of participants to ensure integrity of the evaluation results. The selection of participants shall be based on specific qualifications (see Enclosure 3).

Board and lodging and travel expenses shall be charged against 2025 BEC Funds subject to the usual government accounting and auditing procedures. All travel expenses have been downloaded to the respective regions of the participants. Should transportation expenses exceed the downloaded funds, remaining expenses shall be charged against any available local funds. Participants are expected to bring their own laptop, extension cord, pocket Wi-Fi, and one sample learning resource for LAC Session; wear business attire; and attend all sessions (see Enclosure 4).





## WRITERS' QUALIFICATIONS FOR COLLABORATIVE EXPERTISE LEARNING RESOURCE PACKAGE FOR SPECIAL CURRICULAR PROGRAMS (SCPs)

1. Must possess the minimum academic qualifications required in the discipline of the learning area/program for which they are writing.

2. Must have at least 5 years of experience in basic education teaching the

learning area or handling the program aligned with their discipline.

3. Should have excellent writing skills and a strong background knowledge of the K to 12 Curriculum Guide content (especially content and performance standards and competencies of the curriculum guide for the Special Curricular Program).

4. Must have experience in writing research, books, journals or learning resources aligned with their discipline, published at the school, division,

regional, or national level.

5. Must not be actively involved in any publishing institutions or book distributors during the development process.

6. Should possess appropriate and relevant training in the field of education, including expertise in the learning area content and special curricular activities at the school, division, regional and national levels.

## VALIDATORS' QUALIFICATIONS FOR COLLABORATIVE EXPERTISE LEARNING RESOURCE PACKAGE FOR SPECIAL CURRICULAR PROGRAMS (SCPs)

1. Must have completed the academic requirements for a master's degree aligned with the discipline of the learning area or program.

2. Must have at least 7 years of experience teaching in the discipline or handling the program aligned with the assigned learning area or special curricular

program.

 Should have excellent writing skills and a strong background knowledge of the K to 12 Curriculum Guide content (especially content and performance standards and competencies of the curriculum guide for the Special Curricular Program).

 Must have experience in writing research, books, journals or learning resources aligned with their discipline, published at the school, division,

regional, or national level.

5. Must not be actively involved in any publishing institutions or book

distributors during the development process.

 Should possess appropriate and relevant training in the field of education, including expertise in the learning area content and special curricular activities at the school, division, regional and national levels.


