DISSEMINATION OF GUIDELINES AND OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION ON THE CONDUCT OF THE BASIC EDUCATION INFORMATION SYSTEM DATA COLLECTION FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2024-2025

To Schools Division Superintendent All Others concerned

- In reference to the attached DepEd Memorandum No. 31, s. 2025 on the Basic Education Information System (BEIS) and Validation for School Year 2024-2025 dated April 10, 2025, this Office hereby disseminates the guidelines for compliance by all governance levels within the prescribed timeline. Furthermore, on March 13, 2025, the Department, through DepEd Memorandum 2025-PPS-OD-03-009, conducted an online orientation on the BEIS Data Collection and Encoding for School Year 2024-2025 for Planning Officers across all levels of governance.
- 2. As emphasized in the memorandum and pursuant to DepEd Orders No. 27, s. 2019 and No. 9, s. 2022, the BEIS datasets are vital to delivering quality basic education. Thus, adherence to established standards is required, and the Implementation and Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) Plans for BEIS SY 2024-2025 must be in place to ensure proper execution.
- 3. In this regard, all Schools Division Offices are requested to furnish the Regional Office of the approved *ImPlan* and *M&E Plan* through the following link: **bit.ly/R4aSystem-ImPlan-MnEPlan**.
