Likewise, the validated report must be duly signed and submitted through bit.ly/R4a-Validated-SHA on or before June 23, 2025. Suggested certification template is attached as Enclosure 1 for reference. To effectively manage the data validation process, ensure data accuracy, and address any issues that may arise during the validation period, the composite team may include the Public Schools District Supervisors.
