MONITORING OF THE OPENING OF CLASSES FOR SY 2025-2026

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Regional Functional Division Chiefs
All concerned personnel

- Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 12, Series of 2025 or the Multi-Year Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2025-2026, this Office through the Quality Assurance Division (QAD) and Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), announces the conduct of Monitoring of the Opening of Classes for SY 2025-2026 in the identified Schools Division Offices (SDOs) on *June 16-20, 2025*.
- 2. The purpose of this monitoring as indicated in DO 09, s. 2024 Section V-Item 9, is that "Schools Division offices (SDOs) and Regional Office (RO) shall provide Technical Assistance (TA) through Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E), ensuring that public schools strictly comply with the provisions in this Order. Private schools and non-DepEd schools offering basic education are strongly encouraged to comply with its provisions".
- 3. The monitoring personnel/officials from SDOs and Regional Office are expected to comply with RA 6713 or the Code of Conduct and Ethical Standards of Public Officials and Employees specifically Section 7d, "Public Officials and employees shall not solicit or accept directly or indirectly, any gift, gratuity, favor, entertainment, loan or anything of monetary value from any person in the course of their official duties or in connection with any operation being regulated by, or any transaction which may be affected by the functions of their Office".
- 4. Please refer to the attached Monitoring Tool and School Watching Mapping checklist and the list of regional monitoring personnel/officials. This shall serve as the travel authority for all monitoring teams listed herein.



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- 5. Travel and other related expenses of the regional office personnel/officials relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged against regional funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
