## REGIONAL MONITORING AND VALIDATION ON THE DISTRIBUTION AND UTILIZATION OF SLM-ADM MODULES FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2025–2026

## To Schools Division Superintendents

- In reference to Regional Memorandum No. 398, s. 2025, entitled "Reiteration on the Distribution of SLM-ADM Modules for Schools in Preparation for School Year 2025–2026", and in line with the Department's thrust to ensure timely and adequate access to learning resources, this Office shall conduct a Regional Monitoring and Validation on the Distribution and Utilization of Self-Learning Modules (SLMs) in all public schools across the region.
- 2. This activity specifically aims to:
  - a. validate the accuracy and completeness of SLM-ADM distribution reports submitted by the Schools Division Offices (SDOs);
  - b. monitor the actual utilization of SLM-ADM by schools and learners in relation to the submitted data;
  - c. identify gaps, challenges, and good practices in the handling and use of SLMs; and
  - d. provide technical assistance to SDOs and schools in the utilization of SLM-ADM and the implementation of the Dynamic Learning Program (DLP)-Learning Activity Sheets (LAS).
- 3. The regional validation and monitoring will be conducted during the first week of the opening of classes, in selected elementary and secondary schools across CALABARZON. Schools to be visited will be determined based on the submitted division reports on SLM-ADM distribution. All SDOs are reminded to submit their SLM-ADM distribution status reports through this link: https://tinyurl.com/SLM-ADM-R4A-Report.
- 4. The regional monitoring team shall consolidate and analyze the results of the validation and provide feedback and technical support to the Schools Division Offices (SDOs). The SDOs are expected to ensure the accuracy of their submitted reports, coordinate with the selected schools for site visits, and provide access to relevant data during field validation. Meanwhile, the schools shall facilitate access to SLM-ADM documents, storage areas, and distribution logs, and actively
