**REGIONAL CONVERGENCE ON CURRICULUM
IMPLEMENTATION EVALUATION AND LEARNING
DELIVERY RECALIBRATION OF SPECIAL
CURRICULAR PROGRAMS (SCP)**

To **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. In support to the commitment in ensuring efficient basic education for all learners through effective implementation of Special Curricular Programs (SCP), this Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will hold the Regional Convergence on Curriculum Implementation Evaluation and Learning Delivery Recalibration of SCP on July 23-25, 2025 at a venue that will be announced through a separate issuance.
2. The ultimate goals of this activity are the following:
 - a. report the current implementation status of SCP across Schools Division Offices in CALABARZON by reviewing program data, identifying strengths and gaps, and mapping regional trends in curriculum delivery.
 - b. facilitate collaborative workshops among regional and division SCP coordinators and implementers to identify best practices, share contextualized strategies, and propose solutions to key implementation challenges.
 - c. develop a recalibrated action plan for each SCP that includes short-term and long-term strategies for curriculum enhancement, learner support, and delivery improvement aligned with regional priorities and the Five-Point Agenda.
3. Participants in this activity are the division focal persons in learning delivery. The list of participants, together with the Indicative Program of Activities, Program Management Team (PMT), and Terms of Reference (ToR) will be issued through a separate memorandum.
4. Food and accommodation of the participants shall be charged against Regional Funds. Meanwhile, transportation and incidental expenses may be
