ONLINE VALIDATION OF THE "TRACKING OUR PROGRESS: KINDERGARTEN!": A COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENT GUIDE FOR KINDERGARTEN TEACHERS

To Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. In line with the Advisory dated June 10, 2025, regarding the conduct of an online Orientation Meeting on the Validation Tool of the "Tracking Our Progress: Kindergarten! (A Comprehensive Assessment Guide for Kindergarten Teachers), this advisory outlines the required qualifications and selection parameters for validator-kindergarten teachers to ensure that the feedback gathered is valid, reliable, and contextually appropriate.

Eligibility Criteria for Validators:

- 1. Non-involvement in Tool Development. Must not have participated as writers in the creation of the comprehensive assessment guide.
- 2. Validator Allocation per Division. Each division shall designate a minimum of ten (10) and a maximum of twenty (20) qualified Kindergarten teachers to serve as validators.
- 3. Professional Qualifications
 - · Must be a Master Teacher I or higher, with at least 10 years of teaching experience including a minimum of 5 years in-Kindergarten.
 - · Must have a Bachelor's degree in Early Childhood Education, Kindergarten Education, or a closely related field.
 - · Graduate-level coursework or a Master's degree in Education/ECE is preferred.
- 4. Background Teaching and Experience
 - · A minimum of 5 years teaching experience in Kindergarten is required.
 - Experience handling diverse learners and varied classroom settings is considered an advantage.
- 5. Diversity and Representation. Validators must represent a broad range of geographical contexts across the Philippines, including:
 - · Urban and rural areas;
 - Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDA);
 - Indigenous and multicultural communities.

6. Professional Engagement and Recognition

- · Should have active involvement in curriculum development. Learning resource creation, assessment design, teacher training, or action research.
- · Must be a member of professional learning communities or have experience as a peer mentor.
- · Recognized for teaching excellence, leadership, or meaningful contribution to education (e.g., awards, published work, research presentations, etc.)
